Scholarship Rules

Eligibility & Requirements:

1. All high school seniors, who are members of Co-op Services Credit Union, may apply for scholarships for college or technical school. Co-op Services Credit Union employees, elected or appointed officials, and their dependents are ineligible to apply.
2. Applicants must submit two letters of recommendation, written by a teacher, counselor, employer, friend, clergy or neighbor.
3. Applicants must submit a typewritten essay of 250 words or more, summarizing their personal and educational goals.
4. Applications and documentation must be returned to Co-op Services Credit Union no later than 6:00 pm on February 19, 2010. Applications may be dropped off at any of the eight branches, or by mail to:

5. Scholarship winners are required to provide a copy of their college or technical school's acceptance letter, before funds will be disbursed.

Factors Considered:

- Grade point average.
- Honor courses completed.
- Extracurricular involvement in school, community, religious, and charitable organizations.
- Employment history, if applicable.
- Letters of recommendation.
- Written essay.

Finalist:

All applications will be verified for accuracy. Scholarship recipients will be chosen based on the information submitted and without regard to income, race, color, religion, national origin, sex, handicap, or familial status. Factors considered will be judged as a whole, leading to the choices of seven well-rounded recipients.

Judges:

Judges will be chosen by Co-op Services Credit Union, and the judges' decisions will be final. The judges' choices will be made known to the recipients no later than three weeks from application deadline. All remaining applicants will be contacted by mail after all scholarship recipients have been notified.
