# Make Your Own Trash Can Drum

You'll need the following materials before you get started:

- ★ Small trash can or bucket
- ★ Canvas Square
- ★ Duct tape
- ★ String
- ★ Spray bottle filled with water
- ★ Length of Rope
- ★ 2 wooden spoons

First, cut a square of canvas four inches larger than the diameter of the trash can and lay it across the top of the can so that the edges hang evenly over the rim. (Have mom or dad assist you with any cutting). Tape the corners of the canvas to the can (try alternating sides to get it as

tight as possible), then tape any loose edges down, pulling the drumhead tight as you do so. Tie a string beneath the rim of the can for reinforcement. To tighten the drumhead, spray the canvas with water and then let it dry. Knot a length of rope around the rim then tie the ends to create a shoulder loop. Use the wooden spoons (or your hands) to pound out a rockin' beat!
